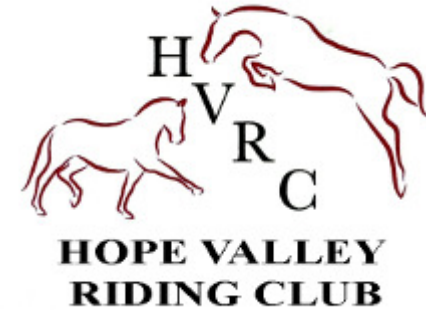


## Club Rules

All competitors in ridden classes must wear hats complying with the new BRC standard for 2016 onwards for safety and insurance reasons. Hats bearing **only** the EN1384 or BSEN1384 standard will no longer be accepted under BHS hat rules for 2016. However, hats would be acceptable if they carry EN1384 or BSEN1384 and another standard such as:

- PAS 015 (1998 or 2011)
- VG1 01.040 (2014-12)
- ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards)
- SNELL E2001 or AS/NZS 3838 (2006 onwards)

- 1.The judge's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- 2.Wearing of riding hats and chin straps to the current BSI standard is compulsory when mounted. Suitable attire to be worn in all rings. From January 2016 onwards, BRC will not accept the EN1384 nor BSEN1384 standard for riding hats unless they are combined with a further standard and a kite mark. Also hats with peaks cannot be worn X country from then. Covers and silks will be allowed.
- 3.The Committee and Organisers do not hold themselves responsible for any accident, loss or damage to competitors, spectators, animals, vehicles or property for any reason.
- 4.The Committee have the right to refuse admission to the showground to any horse or person for any reason.
- 5.Membership must be fully paid up before benefiting from discounted class prices.
- 6.Junior riders must have attained their 3rd birthday on day of show.
- 7.Any horse or pony competing in riding events must be 4 years of age or over in the current year and must be of sound condition.
- 8.No stallions are allowed at club events. Colts (up to one year old) may be brought with an adult handler.
- 9.The Committee reserve the right to measure any horse or pony and to request a height certificate where any height is in dispute. In the event of such action being taken and the animal is found to be of incorrect height, the said animal will be disqualified from the class in question until a height measurement certificate to the contrary has been produced.
- 10.Excessive use of the whip and/or spurs in any class will result in elimination. No whips over 30 inches permitted in any showing class. Spurs must be blunt, turned downwards and not inwards.
- 11.In Lead Rein or First Ridden classes, ponies must be shown in suitable bits and bridles.
- 12.Riders must not gallop or canter anywhere on the showground except in the warming up area or in the rings. Offenders will be asked to leave the showground without refund of entry money.
- 13.It is the competitor's responsibility to enter the ring when asked to do so. Failure to comply may lead to elimination from the class unless the ring steward has been informed of the circumstances.
- 14.Dogs must be kept on a short lead at all times.
- 15.Litter must not be dropped.
- 16.Entry fees cannot be returned except at the discretion of the Show Secretary.
- 17.The decision of the judge is final. Arguing with the judge or general abusive behaviour on the showground will invite elimination.
- 18.Any objection/complaint must be put in writing and handed to the Show Secretary not more than one hour after the class and must be accompanied by £20. If the objection/complaint is found to be justified by the Committee at their next meeting the £20 will be refunded.
- 19.The Committee reserve the right to alter the programme or to consolidate classes or abandon classes. Also to amend or add to these rules as they feel necessary.
20. Non-members competing at the show must hold their own up to date 3rd party insurance

5. **Young Handler(Q)** 12 years of age and under
6. **Cob(Q)** 15.2hh or under, hogged or traditional
7. **Coloured(Q)** Piebald, skewbald, spotted, roan, dun, palomino
8. **Veteran(Q)** 15 years old and over
9. **Prettiest Mare / Handsome Gelding**
10. **Open In Hand(Q)** Judged on best of type
11. **Hunter / Show Hunter Type(Q)**
12. **Show Horse / Pony(Q)**
13. **IN HAND CHAMPIONSHIP** (classes 1 - 12)

**Ridden Classes** Start 10.00am Ring 1 (65m x 30m surfaced arena)

14. **Best Turned Out(Q)** Lead rein welcome
15. **Lead Rein(Q)** Rider 9 years and under
16. **First Ridden(Q)** Rider 12 years and under. No group canter
17. **JUNIOR RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP** (classes 14-16)
18. **Walk Trot Showing** Have a go. No group or individual canter  
*Not to have won a showing class where the show included canter*
19. **Mountain and Moorland(Q)** Large and small breeds
20. **Ridden Youngster** 6 years and under. No group canter
21. **Novice Ridden** Not to have won 3 ridden classes. No group canter
22. **Ridden Cob(Q)** 15.2hh or under, hogged or traditional
23. **Ridden Coloured(Q)** Piebald, skewbald, spotted, roan, dun, palomino
24. **Ridden Horse / Show Pony(Q)**
25. **Ridden Hunter / Show Hunter(Q)**
26. **Ridden Veteran(Q)** 15 years and over
27. **Junior / Senior Riding Club Horse or Pony**  
*Will include a small jump (no filler)*
28. **RIDDEN CHAMPIONSHIP** (classes 18 - 28)

**Working Hunter Classes** Start 10.00 am Working Hunter Ring 3

Combinations can only enter a maximum of 3 working hunter classes.

29. **Starters** not exceeding 30cm Lead rein welcome.  
*Entrants in this class can enter class 30 but no other WH classes*
30. **Beginners(Q)** not exceeding 40cm
31. **Novice Horse / Pony(Q)** not exceeding 50cm  
*Not to have won 3 working hunter classes*
32. **Pairs** not exceeding 50cm One horse follows the other over fences and in the show
33. **Mountain and Moorland(Q)** not exceeding 60cm
34. **Style and Performance** not exceeding 60 cm
35. **Intermediate Horse / Pony** not exceeding 70cm
36. **Open Horse / Pony(Q)** not exceeding 80cm
37. **WORKING HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP**  
(classes 29 - 36)
